This week we have learnt

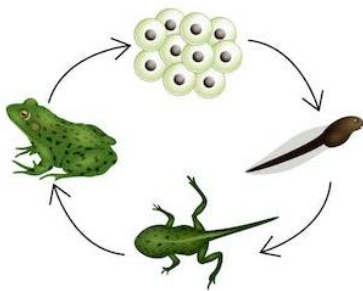
